The Jog-a-thon has been an annual part of the St. Matthew Catholic School tradition for many years.

Every year, our students collect pledges (on a per lap or flat basis) from relatives and friends to sponsor them as they walk, jog, or run around a quarter-mile course. During the Jog-a-thon students complete as many laps as they can during a set time period.

Parent Club sets a fundraising goal for the Jog-a-thon each year. The money raised from this event helps fund St. Matthew Catholic School's operating expenses which are not covered by tuition alone. 100% of the net proceeds will benefit our school. **This year, each child is responsible for raising \$250.00 in pledges.**

All pledge donations are tax-deductible. Recognition and prizes are awarded for our fastest runners for each class and our superstar earners.

For the 2023 Jog-a-thon, St. Matthew Catholic School is using a web based fundraising system called Pledgestar. This system will make it much easier for families and students to request pledges from family and friends. Family and friends can use Pledgestar to easily make secure credit card donations online.

To use Pledgestar, you must first create an account.

From your computer:

- Go to http://pledgestar.com/stmatthewcatholic
- Click "NOT REGISTERED FOR THIS EVENT?"
- Enter your name, email address, and create a password. Then click "submit"
- Follow the instructions on-screen to register Jogger(s) and add family and friends



Pledgestar Set-up Continued:

From your Andriod or Apple Phone or Tablet:

- Go to Apple App Store on IOS or Amazon App store on Andriod and search for "Pledgestar" to download the Family App or go to https://pledgestar.com/stmatthewcatholic/downloadapp.html
- On the home screen enter your event code: "stmatthewcatholic" to locate your event
- Click "NOT REGISTERED FOR THIS EVENT?"
- Enter your name, email address, and create a password. Then click "submit"
- Follow the instructions on-screen to register Jogger(s) and add family and friends

Once you get set up, you can have the system email pledge request to your family and friends. You will get notified each time a pledge is made, and you can track your pledge progress online.

Sponsors who make on-line donations will be able to print out a copy of their donation receipt for tax purposes.

AT THE EVENT: Friday, September 29 at St. Matthew:

<u>Set-up:</u> 7am-8am: Mark the Jog-a-thon course, set-up tents, tables, etc.

<u>Course Monitors:</u> 7:45-11:45 am: Monitor the course for student safety and to ensure that the students are making complete laps.

<u>Teacher Helpers</u>: 7:45-11:45 am: Help an assigned teacher with their students during the games, distributing snacks, bathroom breaks, and more. Archdiocesan background check and CASE training IS required

Snack Squad: 7:45AM - 11:45AM: Set out snacks and water for students and volunteers. Be available to keep the snack area stocked throughout the event. Archdiocesan background check and CASE training IS required

<u>Floaters: 7:45AM – 11:45AM:</u> Cover last minute cancellations, illnesses, or substitutions wherever needed. Archdiocesan background check and CASE training IS required

AFTER THE EVENT:

<u>Data Entry</u>: The hours and dates for this opportunity can be coordinated between the financial office and the volunteer. Volunteers will enter donor information into database. Archdiocesan background check is required.

- · Must be at least 18 years old to volunteer.
- · Please make sure that you have childcare for your small children while you are volunteering.
- · Please come dressed for the weather- this event takes place outdoors.
